Removing Fresno State from the combined State Finals tabulations for the Soil and Land Evaluation Contest. This would make Cal Poly the sole State Finals contest for the Soil and Land Evaluation Career Development Event.

This change was brought up amongst coaches and state staff during the judging season. Rationale: This year we have the lowest numbers of participating schools this year in the Soil and Land Evaluation CDE. Three contests have been canceled this past year, limiting the amount of practice competitions leading up to State Finals (West Hills Winter, West Hills Spring, Reedley Middle College).

By eliminating Fresno State from the combines State Finals scores would provide more opportunities for students to practice and visit the Fresno State Campus for the Soil and Land Evaluation CDE. This would alleviate discrepancies in combined tabulations totals for this contest. This would increase the total number of practice contests to improve student preparation for Cal Poly State finals.

Changes to be made to the Official Manual for Soil and Land Evaluation to change scorecard totals. This will align the changes made in the new Judging Card in 2022.

This contest will affect awards, as Cal Poly will announce the top five teams and individuals for the Soil and Land Evaluation CDE. There is no need for combines scores.

This proposed change will require changes to tabulations for this contest, as there will be no need for combined scores.

This proposed change will affect contest hosting site, as Fresno State will not have to report tabulations to Cal Poly for combined scores.

The proposed change will align the changes with the new Judging Card scorecard and be included in the Official Soil and Land Evaluation Manual text.

Removing the dual-state finals for Soil and Land Evaluation will make Cal Poly the sole state finals contest. No combined scores for tabulations will be necessary. This will help improve the number of practice contests to increase student preparation.
