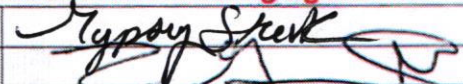

**Description:** (Describe what is changing.)

The purpose of this meeting will be to address four critical areas that because of the implementation of the scantron that do not align with CATA Code from 2022. The subsequent meeting was to develop a new score card that was a waste of time as it never happened. We need to align for clarity these four areas affect by the scantron change: Judging, Grain Grading, Reasons, and ID. Each area needs to be discussed and a recommendation needs to be made to make those areas fit the scantron. State Finals the last two years has made the scantron work and feel they have been legit contest, but code had to be adjusted to make each part work. Basically in order to get one part of code to work you had to adjust another part. Additional forms have been generated that are not code approved to collect contest results and then add points to the scantron.

The biggest problem the last two years is that most contests offered during that time by other sites did not even come close to following code. Every contest was different except MJC and Cal Poly State Finals. So we have to change these 4 sections to make it clear how to use the scantron.

There are four critical parts that need to be addressed in CATA Code and as a result this could create a significant point total drop in this contest. There may be a need to look at the national contest and add back into this contest an area not previously addressed. This contest needs to be flexible to the different host sites but also clear on the rules.

The four critical parts:

1. Judging Classes - only two classes are on scantron while there are four classes in CATA Code, there are some options to make the scantron work but it is not clearly stated in code.
2. USDA Grain Grading - it has been eliminated from National contest and is a challenge for host sites to develop.
3. Reasons Classes - to be adjusted with the final decision on judging classes
4. Identification (Plants) - only 50 ID are available on scantron, contest still says 60. Contest still identifies spelling as part of the points for this area. With a bubble in number available it is impossible to score points for spelling. In addition it is not clear if students may have a list of ID for numeric bubble need purposes. Rules need to be adjusted to clearly state how plant ID will be conducted.
