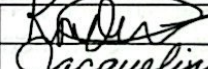
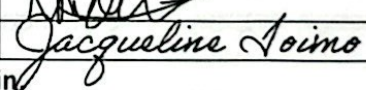

### III. Subjects

A. Contestants may choose their own subjects for their speeches. Any current subject of agriculture which is of interest to the agricultural sector will be acceptable. A topic which centers on leadership and/or FFA experiences is acceptable. References made to FFA and SOEP experiences, as they pertain to the subject, are encouraged. Participants using a topic on a non-related agriculture subject will be disqualified.

B. Topics may include, but not limited too, subject areas that fall under the following categories as it relates to the agriculture industry:

- Economic: Income, Education, Employment Status, Inactivity, Spatial disparities
- Cultural: Religion, Identity, Values and Aspirations
- Political: Security, conflict, and violence, Community and civic engagement, Access to information, Trust in institutions, Participations in decision-making process
- Social: Social networks, age and demography, gender, ethnicity, disability
