Discussion

Recommended to remove tax id test due to test and required text being not related to the contest, the test already being part of the FBM contest and text being expensive.

Need to bring back a budget based problem because it is more relevant as part of the contest. Would like to see the budget problem be built into the SAE plan similar to the scenario portion of the contest. It was discussed that the budget and scenario be potentially connected through the same projects in the contest but was not mandatory.

Some teachers wanted to ensure we have a guideline for the budget portion similar to the old paper based records contest.

Roger Hanagriff added that the budget may be too simple for the scope of the contest and may cause limitations. Some felt the point value may be too high if the budget is too limited or simple. Mr. Mooney felt the contest coordinator for aet could make the budget rigorous enough that it warranted the point value assigned.

Recommendation to clarify unit numbers in the budget and scenario problems and also to specify the time for completing the problem and the questions portion in the curricular code.

Voice vote unanimously adopted the proposed changes to remove the tax if test and add a budget problem with questions.
